# Modesto Junior College Athletics

**History** – Modesto Junior College (MJC) was established in 1921. MJC is one of 112 community colleges in the California Community College System, which is the largest system of public higher education in the world, serving nearly three million students each year.

The MJC Athletics Department offers 21 competitive sports programs (11 men and 10 women), the most in its conference and continues to maintain and work on expanding its selection of offerings. MJC is unique in that its main campus has two primary locations: East Campus and West Campus.

**Mission** – The Modesto Junior College Athletics Department will provide quality instruction, plentiful resources, state-of-the-art facilities, and a respectful environment for our diverse student-athletes, athletics department staff and community.

**Statement of Athletic Philosophy** - The community college offers educational opportunities in a variety of educational, cultural, and personal experiences to fit a wide range of age levels and abilities. Athletics is a part of the Physical Education discipline of our college as a portion of a general education process. A goal at Modesto Junior College is to provide opportunities for men and women to receive advanced instruction as well as a competitive experience. # Coaches Code of Ethics

**Statement:** The list below exemplifies the behaviors expected of a coach at Modesto Junior College. At MJC we strive for the highest standard in coaching excellence.

1. Any sport is the players' game. The paramount concern of coaches is the holistic development, welfare, enjoyment and safety of their players.
2. Coaches bear responsibility for teaching their players to strive for success while playing fairly, observing the playing rules and the highest levels of sportsmanship.
3. Coaches shall treat officials with respect and dignity, and shall teach their players to do the same.
4. Our opponents are worthy of being treated with respect. Coaches will model such respect for opponents and expect their players to do likewise.
5. In both victory and defeat, the behavior of a coach shall model grace, dignity and composure.
6. Coaches shall adhere to the highest standards and the regulations of the institutions they represent: clubs, schools, sponsoring organizations and sports governing bodies.
7. Coaches have a responsibility to promote the interests of sport, including treating media with courtesy, honesty and respect.
8. Coaches shall model inclusive behavior, actively supporting cultural diversity while opposing all types of discrimination, including, but not limited to, racism and sexism, at all levels of sport.
9. Coaches are responsible for taking an active role in education and in the lives of their players.
10. Coaches shall refrain from all manner of personal abuse and harassment of others, whether verbal, physical, emotional or sexual, and shall oppose such abuse and harassment at all levels of their sport.
11. Coaches shall seek to honor those who uphold the highest standards and principles of their sport and shall use appropriate protocol to oppose and eliminate all behavior that brings disrepute to the sport – violence, abuse, dishonesty, disrespect and violations of the rules governing competition.

## **Parking (East/West Campus)**

**East Campus:** Visiting team busses can park along Stoddard Road or on campus parking lots north of the MJC Gym. (see Page 8). Visiting team vans may park anywhere on campus. You may want to consult with the appropriate MJC head coach for the best location.

**West Campus:** Visiting team busses can park on campus at parking lots adjacent to the soccer field or softball field (see page 8). Visiting team vans may park anywhere on campus. You may want to consult with the appropriate MJC head coach for the best location.

**Visiting Fan Parking:** For visiting fans, daily parking permits are \$2.00 and machines are located within all the MJC parking lots. Parking is permitted in all student lots. Parking laws are not enforced on Saturdays, Sundays or after 5:00pm on Fridays (See page 8 for parking lot locations).

## **Locker Rooms**

**East Campus:** Men’s and women’s locker rooms are located next to the gymnasium on Coldwell Ave. Visiting Football teams will use the women’s locker room located north of the MJC swimming pool. Visiting men’s basketball and wrestling teams will use the women’s locker room in the MJC Gym. Visiting women’s basketball and volleyball teams will use the men’s locker room in the MJC Gym. Locker rooms are available for use prior to events and after events. **West Campus:** There is a restroom/dressing room available between the soccer field and softball field.

**Officials:** Football officials dressing room is located at the south end of the Gym (Men’s Team Room). Basketball officials dressing room is located in the PE Office complex (Coaches locker room).

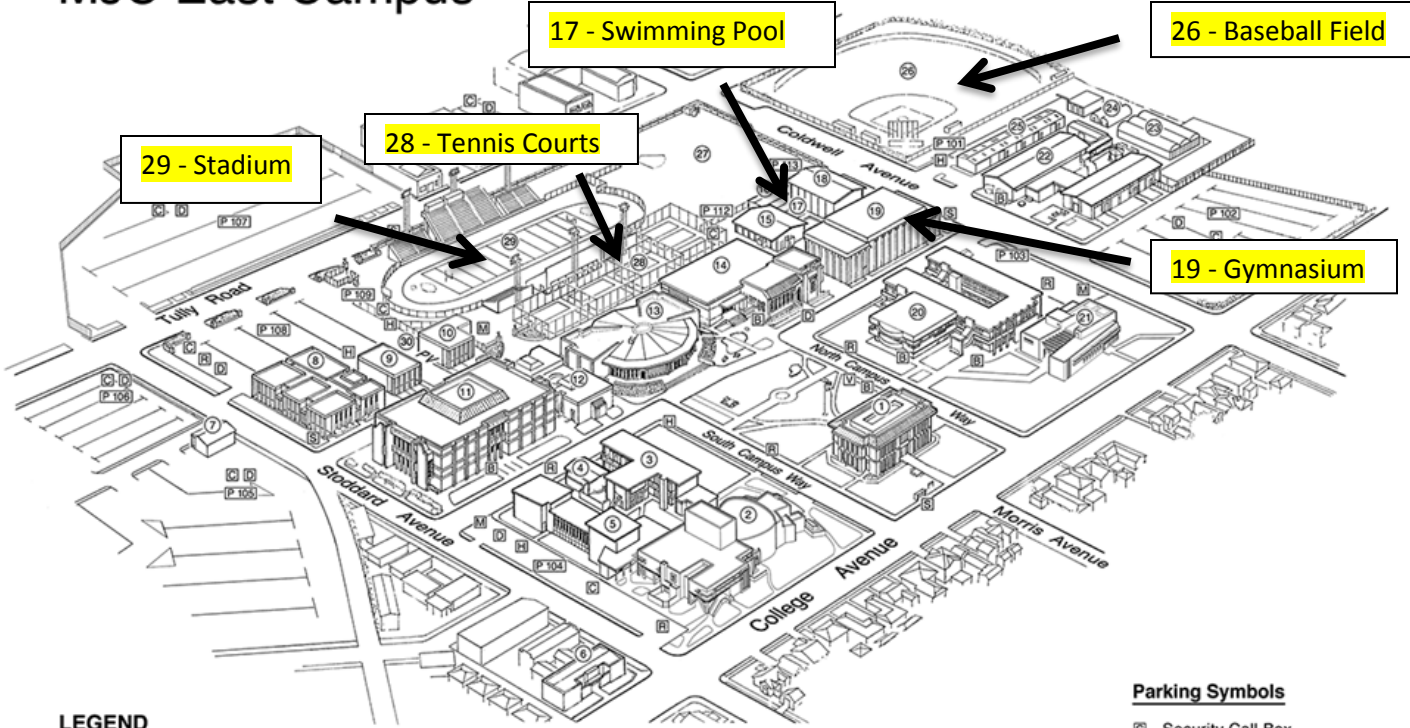

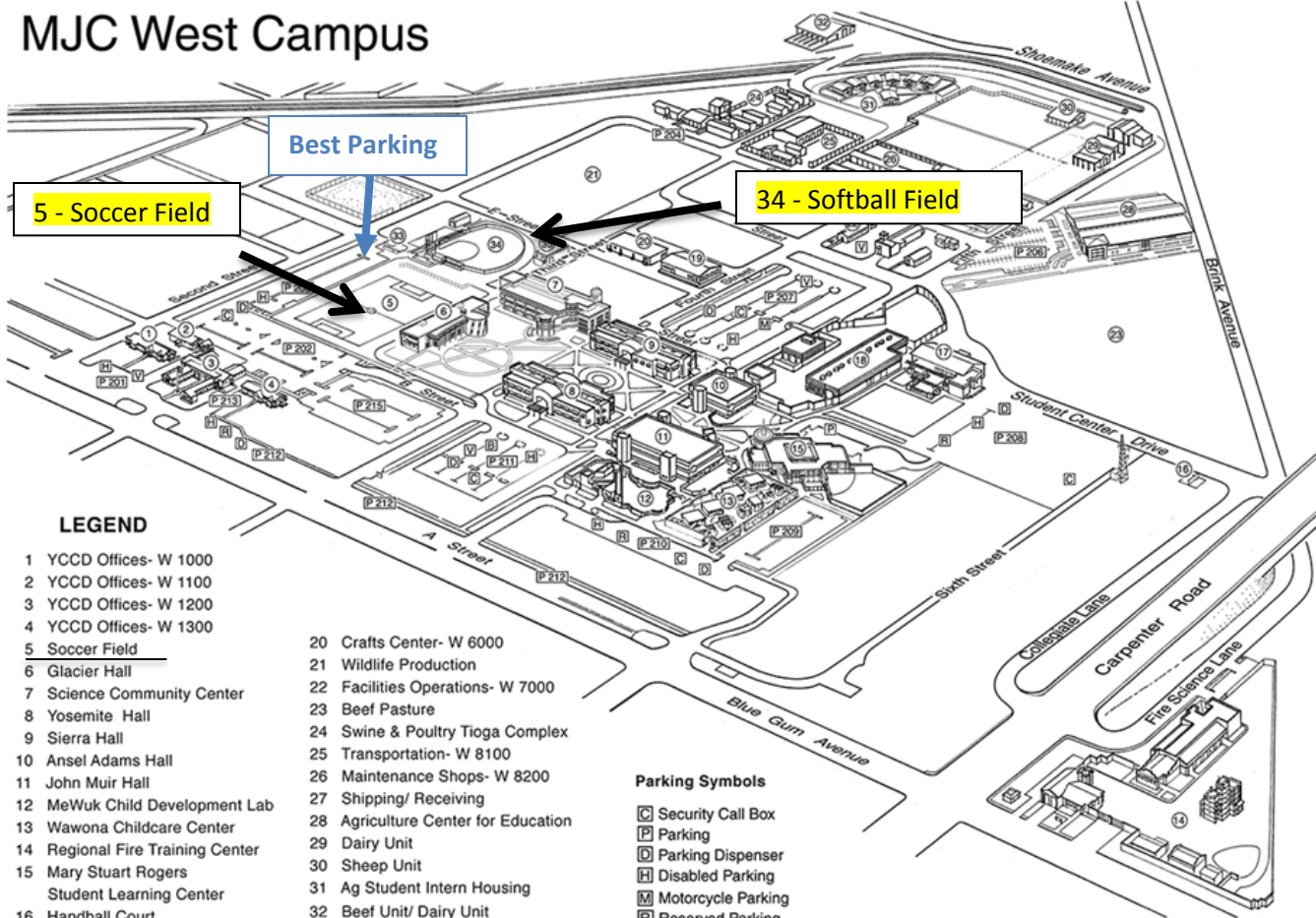

# Decorum Infractions Chart

*(Adopted 4/3/15 effective 7/1/15)*

## Level I

- Assault or attempted assault of a sports official

At a minimum, ejection and suspension from participation in any CCCAA event for 60 months, plus any other sanctions deemed appropriate.

## Level II

- Second ejection in a season

At a minimum, ejection from that contest and suspension from all remaining contests that season, plus any other sanctions deemed appropriate.

## Level III

- Racial or gender slurs/gestures/disrespect
- Drugs, alcohol, or tobacco
- Serious and continuous unsportsmanlike conduct
- Physically assaulting or attempting to assault anyone (other than an official) during an event
- Flashing gang signs
- Bench/sideline involved fights

At a minimum, ejection from that contest and suspension from the next two contests, plus any other sanctions deemed appropriate.

## Level IV

- Ejection from a contest (Coach/Student) for language or unsportsmanlike conduct
- Rulebook infractions
- Leaving position or the bench/sidelines in reaction to an altercation, but not becoming physically involved or verbally confrontational

At a minimum, ejection from that contest, and suspension from the next scheduled contest, plus any other sanctions deemed appropriate.
