Note to Student:

Every person may establish residence unless precluded by the Immigration and Nationality Act (8U.S.C.1101) from establishing residence in the United States.

Establishing residence requires both physical presence in California for one year and one day prior to the beginning date of the term for which you are applying and objective evidence (two forms of proof) that there is the intent to make California your home for other than a temporary purpose. The one year and one day residence period does not begin until you are present in California and have demonstrated clear intent to become a California resident.

You may be required to supply additional information to determine your residency status in accordance with California Education Code, Section 68040 et seq and California Title V, Sections 54000 et seq. The burden of proof to clearly demonstrate both physical presence in California and intent to establish California residence lies with the student. Failure to provide required residency information will result in determination of non-resident.
