**Admission Requirements:** You must be a high school graduate or possess a high school equivalency certificate. You must have an AA degree or higher from a U.S. college or you must take the MJC Accuplacer Reading test and obtain a score of 70 or higher, or complete Reading 82 or higher with a "C" or better. You must pass the program entry exam for math, before the August 4, 2009 deadline. **To be registered with the California Board of Pharmacy you must pass a fingerprinting and criminal background check. The State of California may deny you registration if you have a felony conviction.**

**Completion Requirements:** You must attain a C average or better in quizzes and examinations for all instructional modules and complete all laboratory & experiential work with a grade of S (satisfactory) or better to be eligible for MJC certification. MJC certification meets the CA State Broad of Pharmacy requirements for registration as a pharmacy technician.

**Upon acceptance into the program, final payment is due by Tuesday, September 1, 2009, unless other arrangements have been made.**

**Drop or Repeat Course Policy:** Students may withdraw registration for the program on or before the official drop date of October 2, 2009 for any reason. Tuition paid will be refunded less a \$1000.00 administrative fee.

Students in good standing may drop the course after the official drop date of October 2, 2009 for personal reasons with approval of the Program Director. Tuition will not be refunded. Students who withdraw under these conditions may reapply for the following course offering and will have priority status with the Admissions Committee. If readmitted, these students must pay the \$1000.00 administrative fee, but will not have to pay the remainder of the tuition for the readmission. Students who fail the course or who do not complete all requirements, including Externship, within one year of the program start date may reapply one time only for the next class offering and will be evaluated for readmission without special consideration. There is no guarantee that students in this status will be readmitted to the program. If the student is readmitted, he or she will be required to repay the full tuition amount and comply with all course requirements.

**Refund Policy:** Students who pay the entire registration fee up front may drop on or before the official drop date of October 2, 2009 for any reason. Tuition paid will be refunded less a \$1000.00 administrative fee.

Students who sign a promissory note with MJC Community Education (this requires a minimum of a \$2500.00 down payment):

You may drop on or before the official drop date of October 2, 2009, and you will be refunded amount paid minus the \$1,000 administrative fee.

If you drop AFTER the official drop date of October 2, 2009, you will be responsible for the entire amount of the tuition. After trying to collect outstanding balances, the Modesto Junior College Business Office will send all outstanding balances to collections. This will affect your credit history.
