Did you know that you can check the status of your financial aid documents without calling the Financial Aid Office?

Filing a FAFSA is the first step in applying for financial aid. MJC Financial Aid will send an email to your MJC Email Account regarding additional documents needed once your FAFSA has been received.

Check your MJC Email Account for important notices or document requests from the Financial Aid Office.

You can also log on to your EDS account at www.mjc.edu/faforms. Once you are logged in, you will see any online forms you need to submit.

In addition, you can go to www.mjc.edu and select PiratesNet, then under "Financial Aid" on the left side menu, click on "My Documents".

- If a document shows "Submit Now," the document has not yet been received.
- If a document shows "Received," your document has been received by our office and is awaiting review by a Financial Aid Technician.
- If a document shows "Processed," your Technician has completed review of the document.

After all your documents are processed, an email notification will be sent to your PiratesLink email account regarding your eligibility.

*MJC Financial Aid reviews applications based on the date documents were first submitted. (PLEASE NOTE that this is **not** your FAFSA filing date, but the date you first submitted requested documents to the Financial Aid Office.)*
