

**U.S. Colleges and Universities with Smokefree Air Policies**

While it has become relatively common for colleges and universities to have policies requiring that all buildings, including residential housing, be smokefree indoors, this list only includes those colleges and universities with entirely smokefree campuses, or with entirely smokefree campuses with a minor exemption for smoking in limited, remote outdoor areas.

Please note, these policies have been enacted but are not necessarily yet in effect. Please contact the school itself to verify the status of its policy.

## **No Smoking Policy**

As of August 20, 2009 the Chabot College Council passed a resolution to delete the on-campus smoking provisions of our smoking policy. All smoking is limited to the parking lots only.

### **SRJC Enforces No Smoking Ordinance**

With the opening of the fall semester, which starts August 17, 2009, the SRJC District Police will begin issuing citations to enforce the City of Santa Rosa's no-smoking ordinance on and near the Santa Rosa Campus and SRJC's Southwest Center. Smoking is prohibited not only on the college's property, but also within 20 feet of all District property, including all sidewalks and a portion of the city streets adjacent to college property. City fines for smoking ordinance violations are up to \$100 for the first offense, \$250 for the second offense, and \$500 for each subsequent offense.

**San Diego Mesa College** is a smoke-free campus. This directive is intended to prevent the serious health risks associated with exposure to second-hand smoke. Those who choose to smoke must do so outside the campus perimeter. Thank you for your cooperation.

### **POLICY STATEMENT FOR A TOBACCO FREE CAMPUS**

It is the policy of Imperial Valley College to provide a tobacco free environment for its students, faculty, staff, administrators, visitors and the general public while on this campus. The simple separation of smokers and nonsmokers within the same air space may reduce, but does not eliminate, the exposure of nonsmokers to environmental tobacco smoke, nor does the EPA recognize a safe level of exposure to environmental tobacco smoke.

Effective the **FIRST DAY OF THE FALL SEMESTER 2009**, Imperial Valley College shall be a tobacco-free campus. The use of any tobacco products shall be prohibited on any district properties. The sale of tobacco products on campus is prohibited.

Appropriate signs shall be posted at all entrances to campus grounds.

Smoking shall be prohibited at all times in all vehicles on campus.

The smoking prohibition applies to passenger vehicles and all other state owned mobile equipment to include light and heavy trucks, cargo, and passenger vans, buses, and any other mobile equipment with an enclosed or enclosable driver/passenger compartment.

Any student or visitor found in violation of the Policy Statement will be forwarded to the Associate Dean of Student Affairs as per the Standards of Student Conduct (4) *Willful persistent smoking where smoking has been prohibited.*
