Student Learning Outcomes (SLO) Coordinator Position**

Proposed by: MJC Academic Senate SLO Committee – Michael Sundquist, Chair

Whereas: The development of measurable student learning outcomes is important to the improvement of teaching and learning at Modesto Junior College, and

Whereas: The development of measurable student learning outcomes at the course, program and college levels is an important focus of the new accreditation standards, and

Whereas: It is the responsibility of the faculty to design and implement changes to courses and programs, and

Whereas: It is necessary to lead and support faculty efforts to develop measurable student learning outcomes with training resources; coordination of mentors; analysis of assessment results and other related activities,

Therefore: **Be it resolved** that the Academic Senate support the establishment of a SLO Coordinator beginning no later than the Fall 2005 semester and that the Senate’s SLO Committee be charged with developing a job description and screening applicants for said position.

Therefore: **Be it further resolved** that this SLO Coordinator position have adequate support staff time, budget and office space in order to program associated activities.

Therefore: **Be it further resolved** that the SLO Coordinator shall chair the Senate SLO Committee coordinate activities with the Academic Senate President.
