Search for a Permanent District
Chief Information Systems Officer (CISO)**

- Proposed by:** Senate Committee on the Implementation of Administrative Hardware
- Whereas,** computer technology is an integral part of the mission of the college; and
- Whereas,** centralized, highly-integrated computing systems impact the educational mission of the college; and
- Whereas,** a permanent Chief Information Systems Officer (CISO) is essential to computer technology advocacy for the district and its campuses; and
- Whereas,** it is imperative that the primary loyalty of the CISO is to the best interests of the District and colleges rather than outside organizations; and
- Whereas,** time is needed to transition from a technology-outsourcing company to a permanent technology executive; and
- Whereas,** the delay in hiring a permanent CISO may result in higher costs due to continued outsourcing of such a position; and
- Whereas,** faculty are highly involved in both faculty and administrative hiring procedures; and
- Whereas,** shared governance should exemplify parity in hiring procedures, no matter the rank,
- Therefore,** **Be it resolved** that the Academic Senate of Modesto Junior College recommends to the Yosemite Community College District that the search for a permanent CISO commence as soon as possible and that the CISO Search Committee be comprised of appropriate faculty, staff, and administrators from the District and its college campuses.
