Resolution SP07-B  
Intervention After Second Withdrawal (W)**

- Proposed by:** Ad Hoc Third Enrollment Task Force
- Whereas:** MJC is now requiring students who have received two withdrawals and/or substandard grades from the same course to petition for a third attempt; and
- Whereas:** MJC now blocks all students with two withdrawals and/or substandard grades from the same course; and
- Whereas:** A student's counselor is an important resource in career planning and student success and has a more realistic view of skills needed for success.
- Therefore:** **Be it resolved**, that the Academic Senate recommends that students meet with a counselor to assess reasons for non-completion of a course in two attempts (two W's), and to help establish an intervention plan, if needed.
- Be it further resolved**, that MJC stop the practice of blocking student enrollment from a course after two previous attempts that resulted in a withdrawal; or two previous attempts where a student received a substandard grade and/or a withdrawal.
- Be it finally resolved**, to refer the third attempt challenge to the Student Success Committee for investigation and resolution.
