Distance Education Definitions: Distance education (DE) means instruction in which the instructor and student are separated by distance and interact through the assistance of communication technology. Whether a course is to be considered as DE, the basic criterion established in the GUIDELINES (March 2004) under Section 55205 needs to be applied (i.e., a distance education course/section or session utilizes technology 51 percent or more of the time to deliver instruction during the course term.)

Retention Rate = Numerator: Number of enrollments with A,B,C,D,F,CR,NC,I,P,NP

Denominator: Number of enrollments with A,B,C,D,F,CR,NC,W,I,P,NP,DR

Success Rate = Numerator: Number of enrollments with A,B,C,CR,P

Denominator: Number of enrollments with A,B,C,D,F,CR,NC,W,I,P,NP,DR - (from CCCCO Data Mart)
