1. How many students have petitioned for additional reenrollments?

Total for 04/05 = 997 (a 95.68% increase over last year).
 How many due to "W"? Of the 595 approved petitions, 430 were due to the "W."

2. How many of these petitions have been approved?

Total for 04/05 "3rd or more enrollment" approved = 595

3. For approved petitions, what interventions were approved?

The committee indicates recommendations such as: Counseling, Tutoring, Supplemental Instruction courses, limited unit load, and taking the prerequisite course. Students commit to these interventions as a condition of the granting of a third enrollment, but there are no systems in place to track compliance with these interventions.
