#### CONSENT FOR RELEASE OF INFORMATION (ELECTRONIC FORM #9A)




All telephone or e-mail inquiries for specific financial aid information require written authorization. *If you have not previously established a security code with the Financial Aid Office, you must complete **Electronic Form #9A** if you want to authorize the Financial Aid Office to discuss your application information with you by telephone or e-mail.*

#### IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO REPORT THE FOLLOWING ADDITIONAL INFORMATION IF IT APPLIES TO YOU:

If you pay for dependent care, use **Electronic Form #9G** to report these expenses to the Financial Aid Office. This information will be used to determine your cost of education and may increase your financial aid eligibility.

If you will receive assistance for educational expenses from an outside agency (such as Veterans Educational Benefits or Vocational Rehabilitation) from July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010, you *must* report your expected benefits. **Resources include cost of books, tuition, and other related expenses.** Use **Electronic Form #9H**.
