Submit the completed form to the MJC Records Office on East Campus, Morris Building, Room 107, 575-6856, (home campus) for eligibility verification. After the records office has verified eligibility for cross enrollment, the student can pick up the form from Morris 107. ▪ Submit the verified form to the CSUS Admissions & Records office, 667-3152 (host campus) and identify the course of interest. ▪ Attend the first day of class to obtain permission to add if there is space available. ▪ Submit the add form to CSUS Admissions & Records Office for processing. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Call Extended Education, 667-3111. ▪ Complete the Open University application and seek permission to enroll on the first day of classes. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Apply for admission to MJC and CSUS at the same time. ▪ On the CSUS application, indicate that you are applying for Dual Admissions ▪ Begin courses at MJC ▪ During the last semester at MJC, reapply to CSUS campus and notify the CSUS campus of original application coded under Dual Admissions ▪ Questions: Call CSUS student outreach at 667-3070

The 2-year articulation agreement may be subject to change. Students should contact the student outreach center (667-3070) to verify this time period requirement.
