

COVID-19 PROTOCOLS SPRING 2022

GUIDANCE FOR GROUPS & EVENTS

GENERAL RULES WHEN USING OUTDOOR MJC FACILITIES

- All groups are not required to wear mask, although they are encouraged.
- Social distancing is still required if possible.
- All groups do not need provide proof of vaccination or a negative COVID-19 test within 72 hrs. of coming to campus.

GENERAL RULES WHEN USING INDOOR MJC FACILITIES

- All groups/participants will need to wear masks while indoors.
- Please refer to the guidelines for individual types of group for further instructions.

MJC ACADEMIC CLASS (INDOOR FACILITIES)

- All students and faculty must show proof of vaccination or negative COVID-19 test 72 hrs. of coming to campus. This will be handled through District for classes.

OUTREACH PROGRAMS THROUGH MJC DEPARTMENTS (INDOOR FACILITIES)

- Examples would be Career Expo through Workforce or tours through SSSP/Student Outreach and Success. AHC shows for schools would also fall under this.
 - Kids (K-12) will not need to provide proof of vaccination or negative COVID-19 test within 72 hrs. of coming to campus.
 - Adults from outside school/organizations traveling with students will need to supply the proof of vaccination or negative COVID-19 test within 72 hours of coming to campus.

GREAT VALLEY MUSEUM TOURS (INDOOR FACILITIES)

- If tour group is from a K-12 school, then kids will not need to show proof of vaccination or negative COVID-19 test before coming to campus.
 - Adults will need to show proof of vaccination or negative COVID-19 test within 72 hrs. of coming to campus. If tour group is adults or people coming on their own, then all ages would need to provide proof of vaccination or negative COVID-19 test within 72 hrs. of coming to campus.

MTS/MEITS/PRE-COLLEGE ACADEMY (INDOOR FACILITIES)

- If student and staff from the high school are just using one of our classrooms and not mixing with college population, then both students and staff do not need to show proof of vaccination or negative COVID-19 test within 72 hrs. of coming to campus.
- If the student does decide to take a separate MJC course that's out of their program hours, then they would be then considered an MJC student and will have to provide proof of vaccination or negative COVID-19 test within 72 hrs. of coming to campus.

COMMUNITY EDUCATION CLASSES (INDOOR FACILITIES)

- For any Community Education class that is child related, kids (ages K-12) are not required to provide proof of vaccination or negative COVID-19 test within 72 hrs. of coming to campus.
 - Examples would be kid camps, cooking classes, etc.
- For any Community Education that is not kid related, all students and staff will need to provide proof of vaccination or negative COVID-19 test within 72 hrs. of coming to campus.
 - Examples are jewelry and metal craft classes, yoga classes, dancing classes, Notary exams, etc.

EVENTS/ACTIVITIES- INCLUDES CO-SPONSORED (INDOOR FACILITIES)

- Examples of facilities: ACE Pavilion, Gymnasium, Performing Arts Auditorium, Recital Hall, classrooms, Student Center, Mary Stuart Rogers will require all participants to provided proof of vaccination or negative COVID-19 test within 72 hours of coming to campus.
 - Only exception to this requirement is if the event/activity is for participant groups of K-12 ages only; then proof of vaccination or negative test are NOT required. Examples would be Science Olympiad, Math Bowl, 4-H Proficiency Day. Any adults participating will need to provide proof of vaccination or negative COVID-19 test.

TRANSPORTATION

- All vehicles and bus capacity will be full capacity within the vehicle however proof of vaccination or negative COVID-19 test within 72 hours of being in vehicle. Masks will still be required while in the vehicle.
