MJC Basketball to hold Coaches vs. Cancer Night at February 20 home games

(Modesto, CA) – The Modesto Junior College Basketball program will hold a Coaches vs. Cancer Night on Friday, February 20 during MJC’s final home games, with 50% of the ticket sales donated to the American Cancer Society.

The Pirates will play Diablo Valley College, with the women’s basketball teams tipping off at 5:30 p.m. and the men’s teams playing at 7:30 p.m. in the MJC Gymnasium on East Campus.

The Coaches vs. Cancer program is a nationwide collaboration between the American Cancer Society and the National Association of Basketball Coaches that is supported by the California Community College Athletic Association.

MJC’s Coaches vs. Cancer Night provides an opportunity to increase cancer awareness on campus and in the community, and raises money to fight the disease.

Tickets to the basketball night are \$7 general admission, \$5 for senior citizens and students, and \$3 for children (7-10 years old). Children under six years of age are free.
