February is CTE Awareness Month

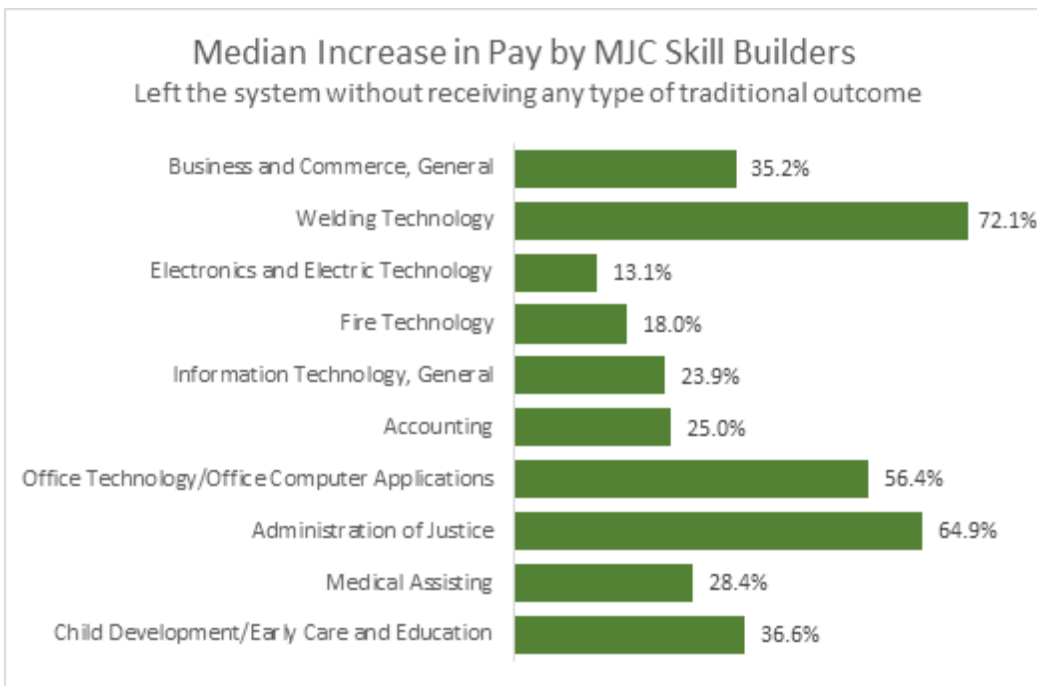
As we bring to an end CTE Awareness Month, we would like to bring attention to a non-traditional student pathway, that of the Skill Builders.

What are skills-builders?

- Workers who are maintaining and adding to skill-sets required for ongoing employment and career advancement.
- These students do not earn community college certificates or degrees and don't transfer to a four-year institution.
- Most skills-builder take only one or two CTE courses.
- Most skills-builders are older students, who have had experience in the workforce.

MJC Skill-builders are:

23	Median Age, 29 for State
52%	Female, 44% Female for State
44%	Hispanic, 34% for State
6	Median units earned in 2016-2017 Academic Year (4 for State)
84%	Success Rate in CTE Courses
