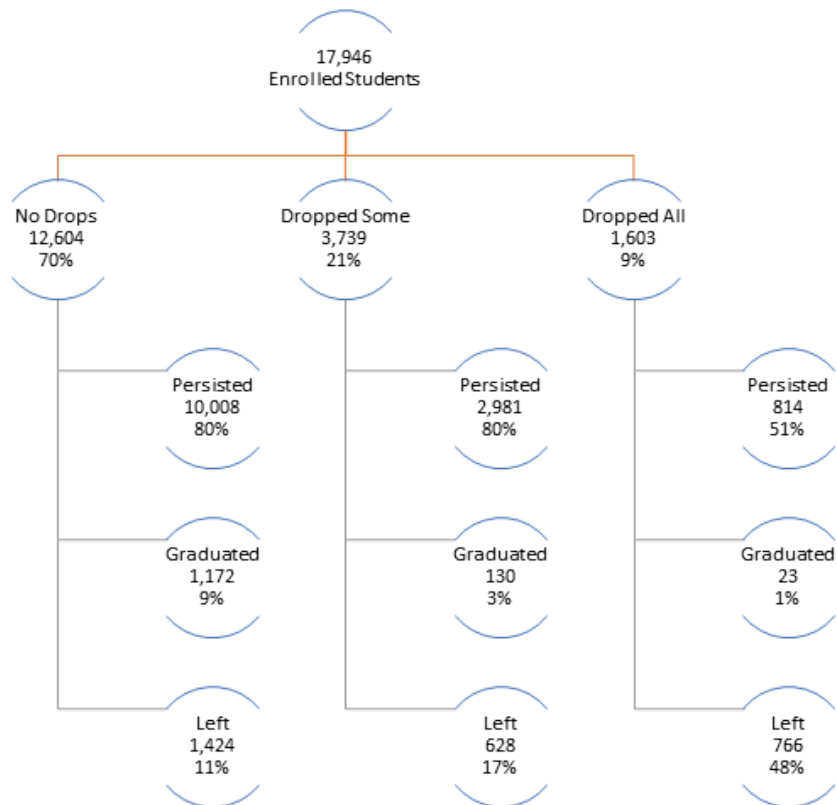

MJC Just the Facts 2017

2016 Fall Students; Persistence, Graduation and Drops



- In fall 2016, 5,342 students dropped *on or more* courses before the end of the semester.
- Of those the 70% who *did not drop any* classes in the fall, 9% of them graduated by Spring 2017.
- Of those who dropped *some* of their courses, 17% did not return to MJC.
- Of those who dropped *all* of their courses, 48% did not return to MJC.
