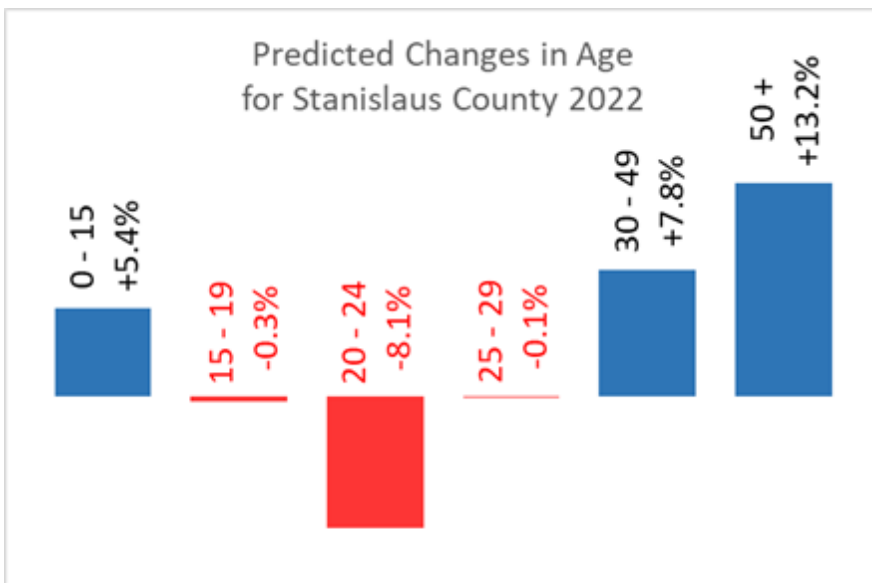

Predicted Changes in Stanislaus County Demographics

In Stanislaus county:

- The population between the ages of 20 to 24 years is projected to decrease by 8% between 2014 and 2022.
- The Hispanic population is projected to increase by 16% between 2014 and 2022.
- Less than one-third of adults have a bachelor's degree.
- Less than 25% of African Americans and less than 15% of Hispanic adults have a bachelor's degree.
