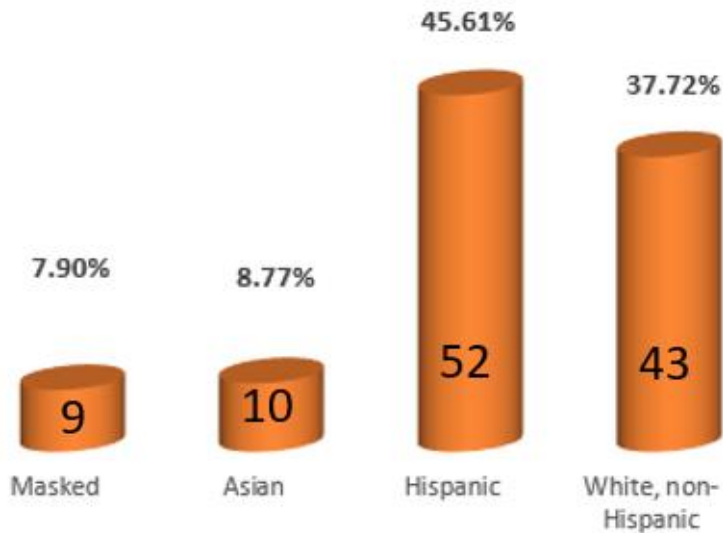

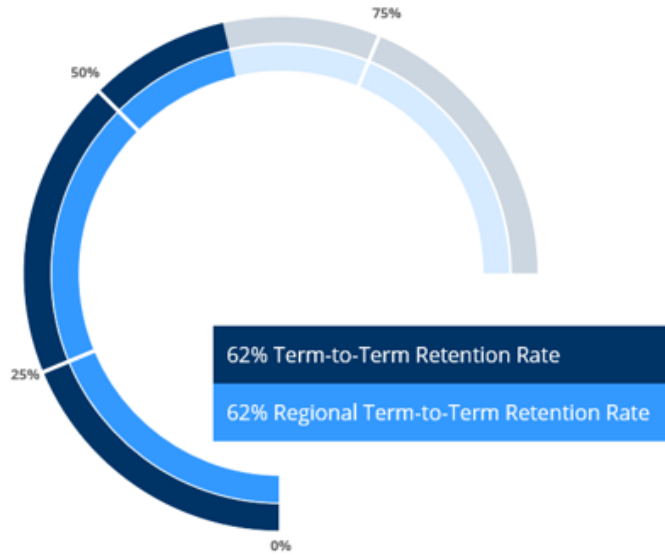


Definition: Students who declared MJC Computer Electronics program during the 2017-2018 year.

Computer Electronics Program: Student Ethnicity



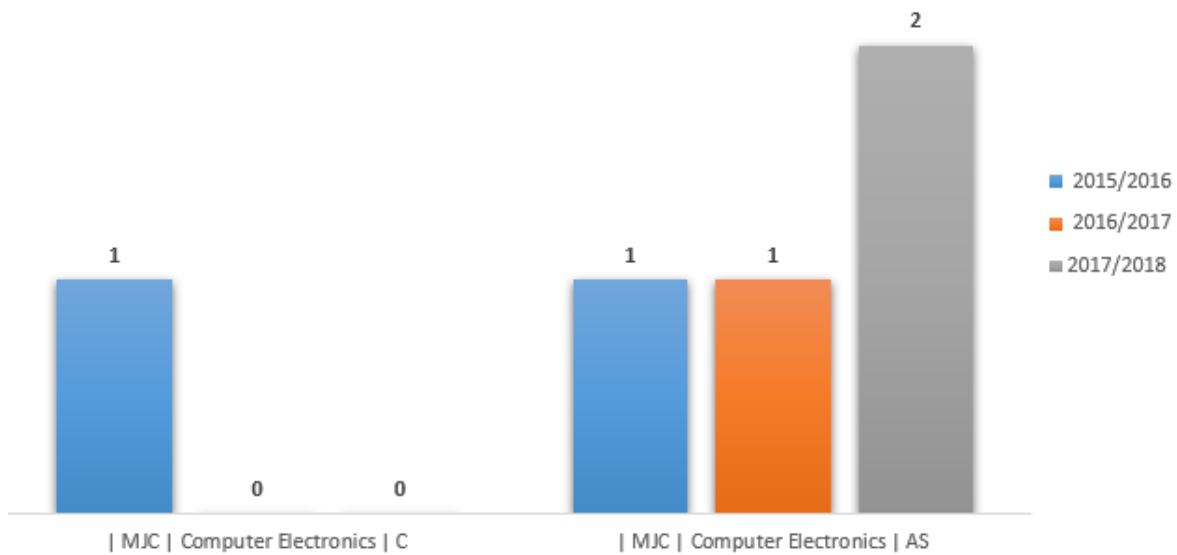
Definition: Demographic breakdown of student Computer Electronics program majors, 2017-18

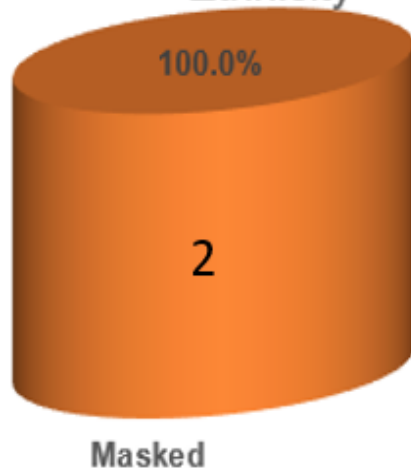

Computer Electronics Program Student Award Trend



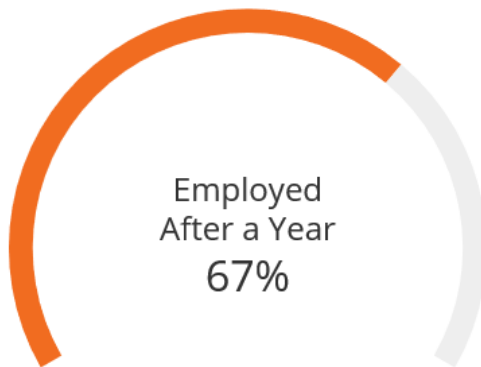
Definition: Three-year award trend data (degree or certificate)

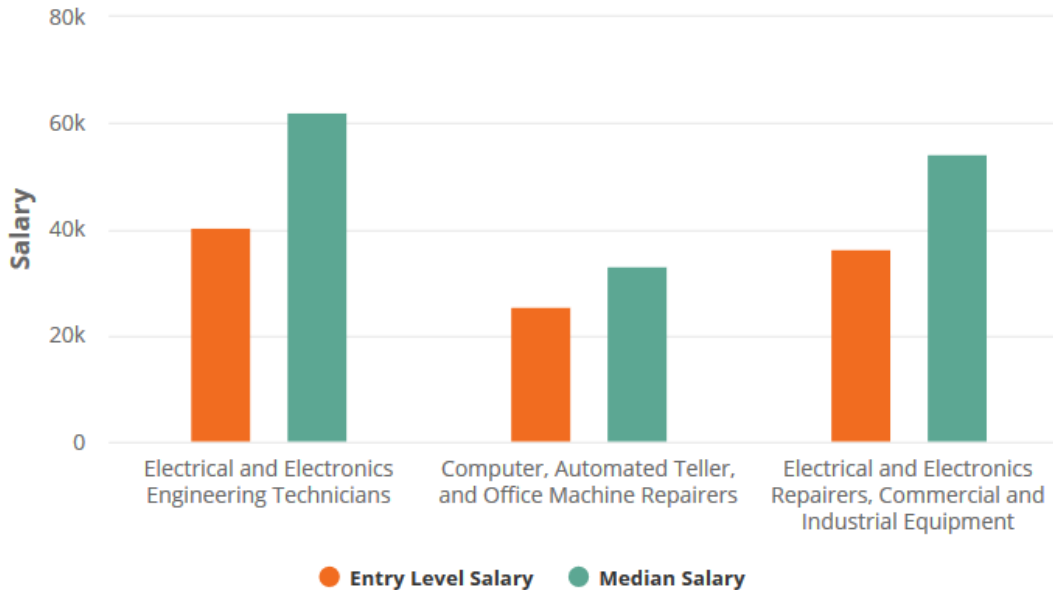
