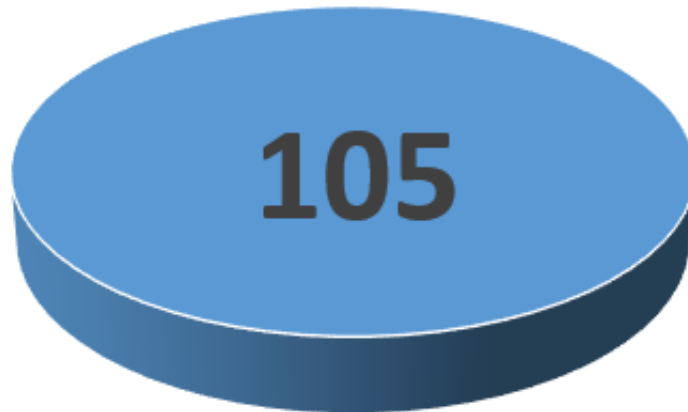
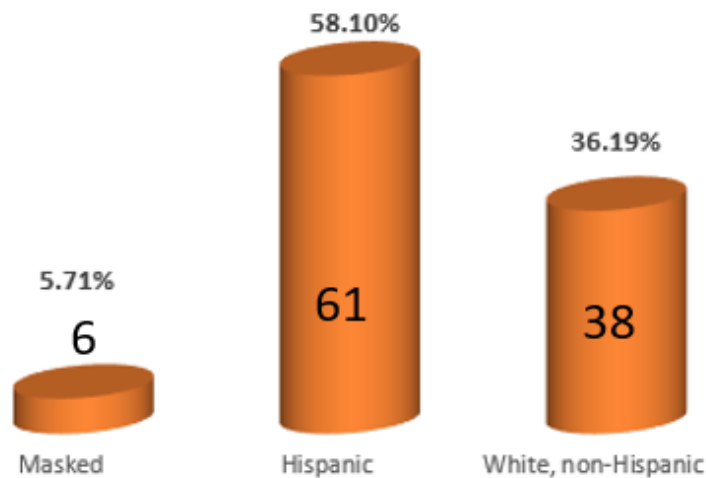

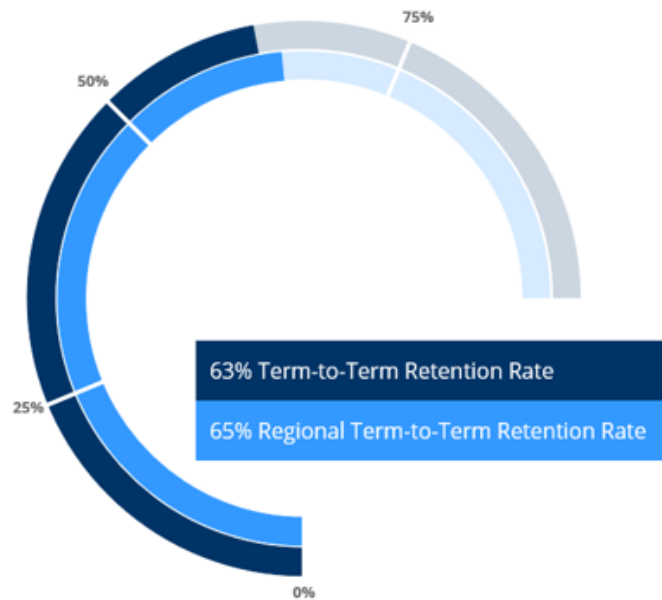


Definition: Students who declared MJC Environmental Horticulture program during the 2017-2018 year.

Colleague Student Demographic, 2017-18



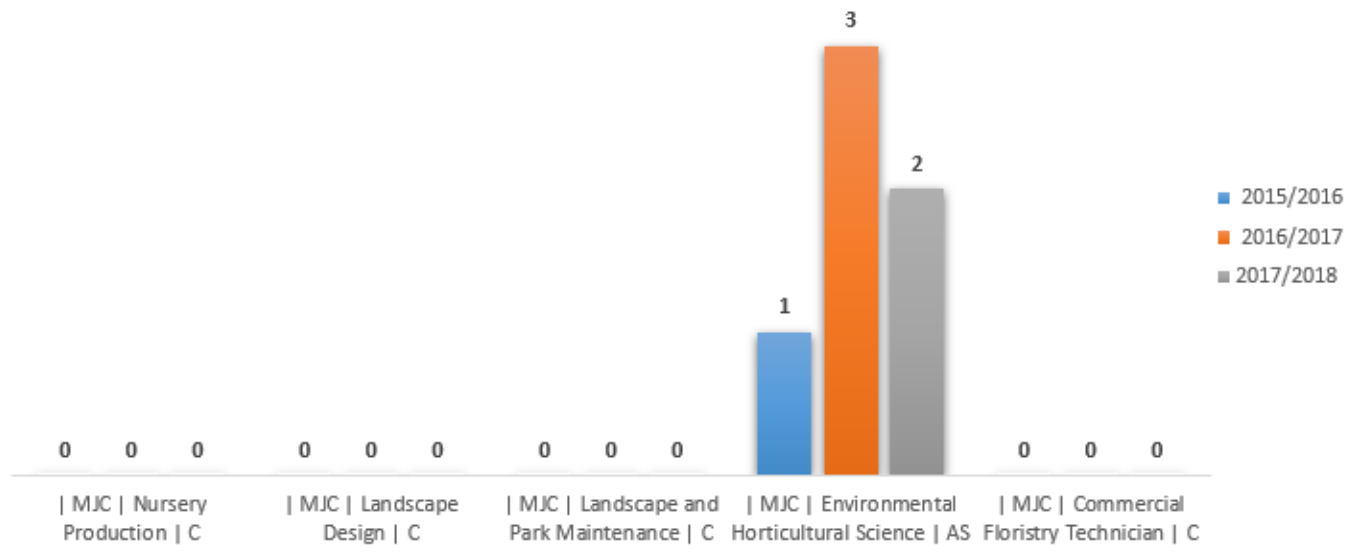
Definition: Among students, the proportion retained from fall census to spring census at college in the selected year.

### Environmental Horticulture Program Student Award Trend

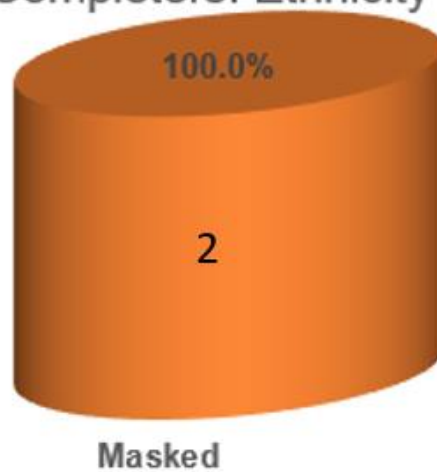


Definition: Three-year award trend data (degree or certificate)
