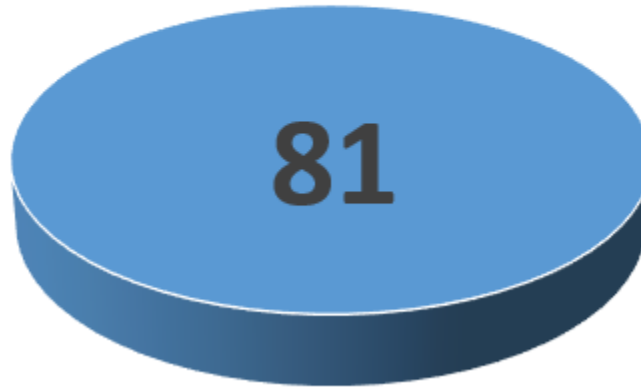
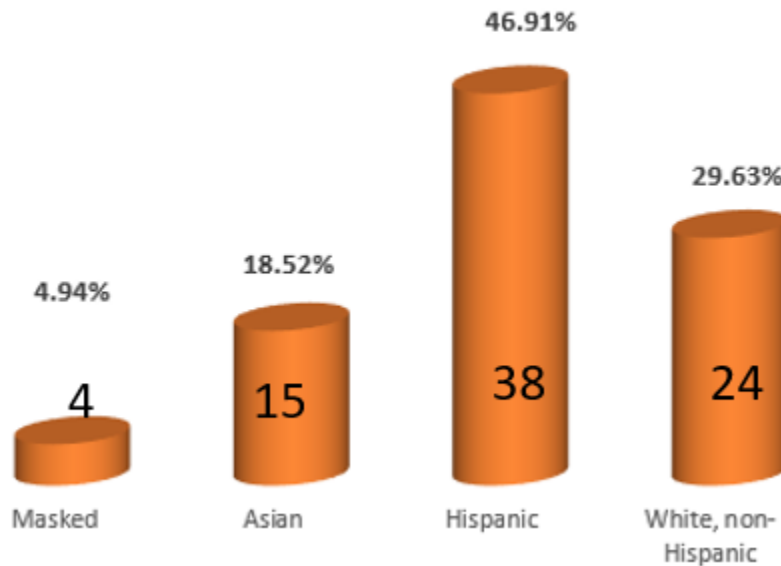


Language Studies Program Students 2017-2018

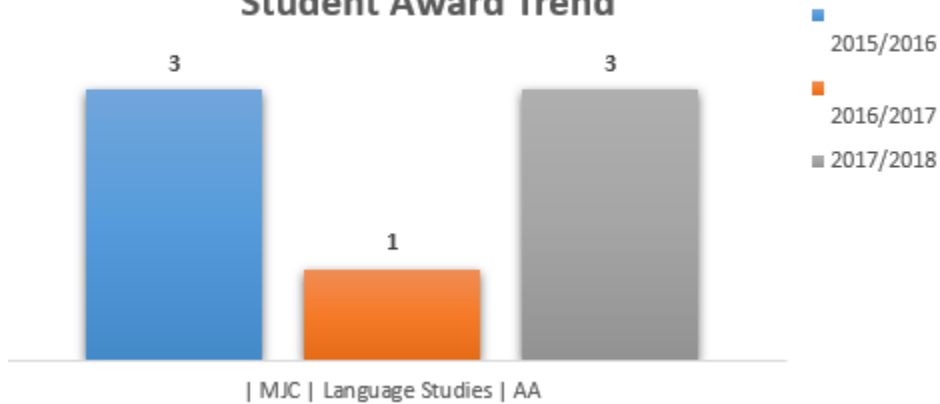
Language Studies Program: Student Ethnicity

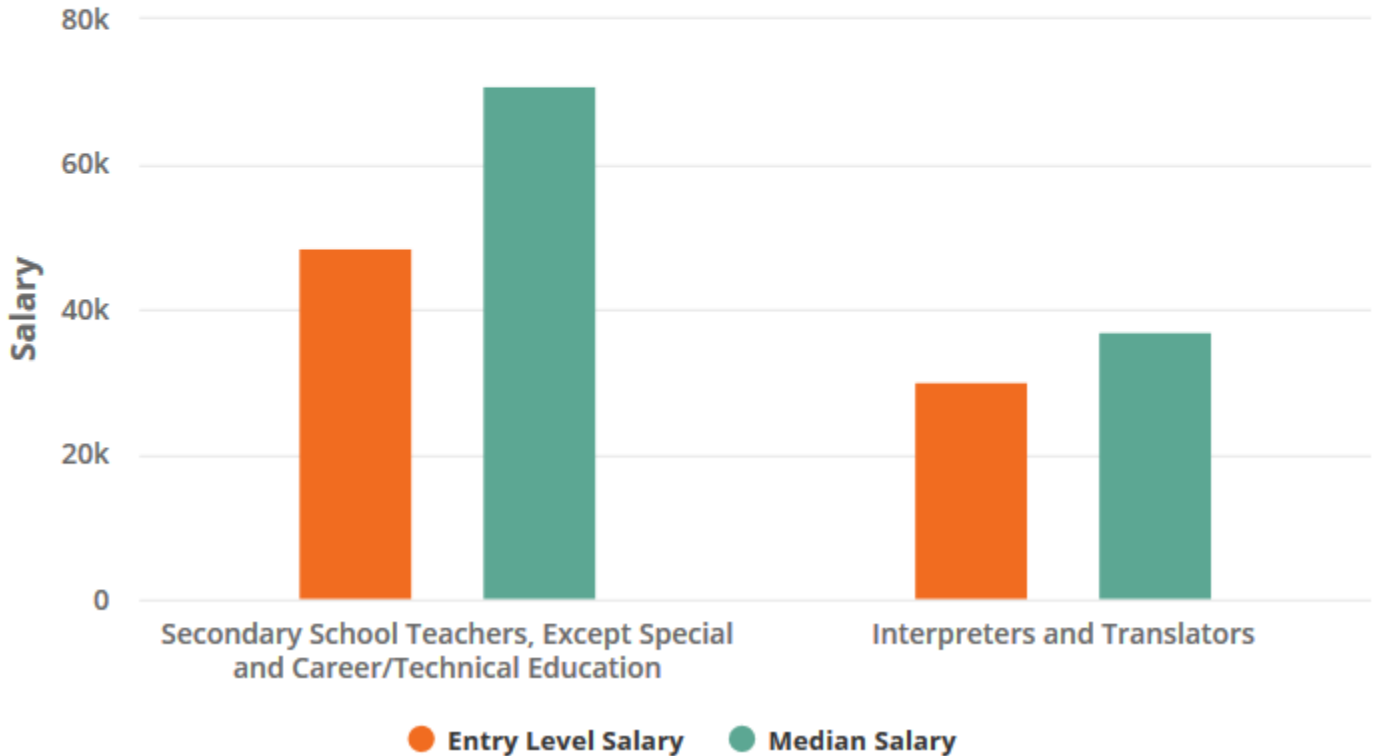
