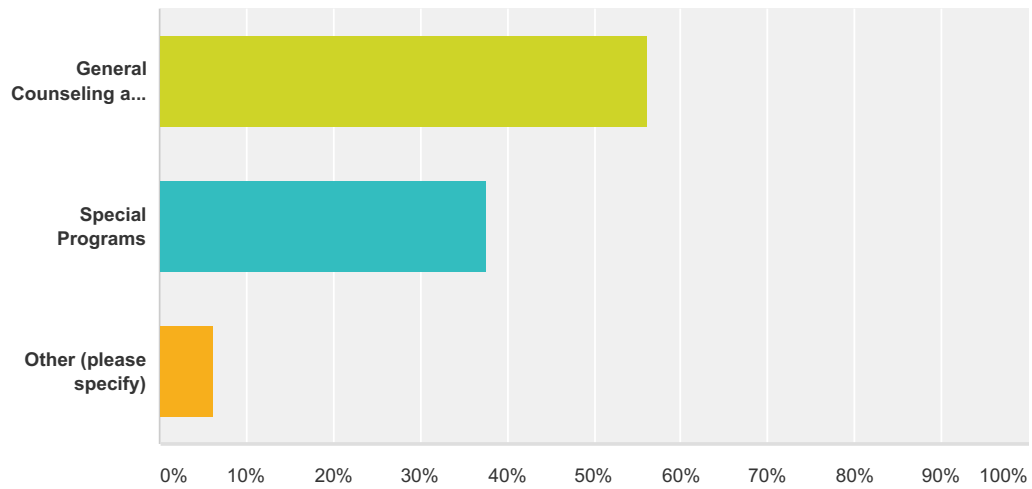


Q1 In which Division or Department at MJC are you located?

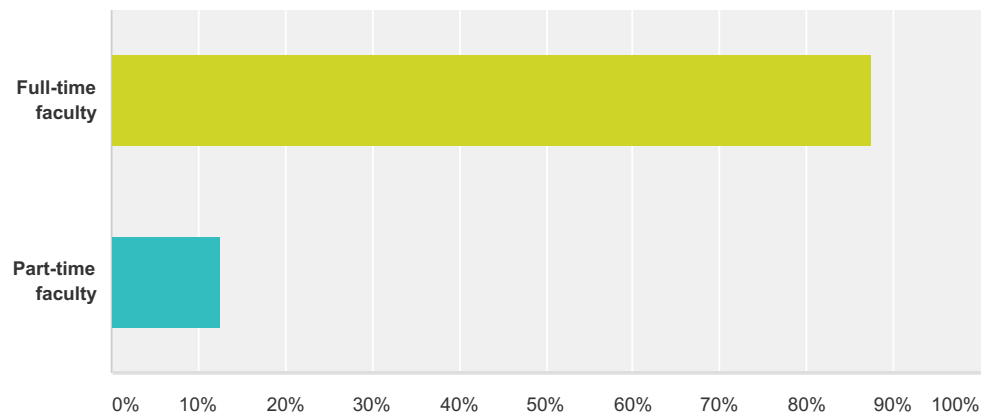

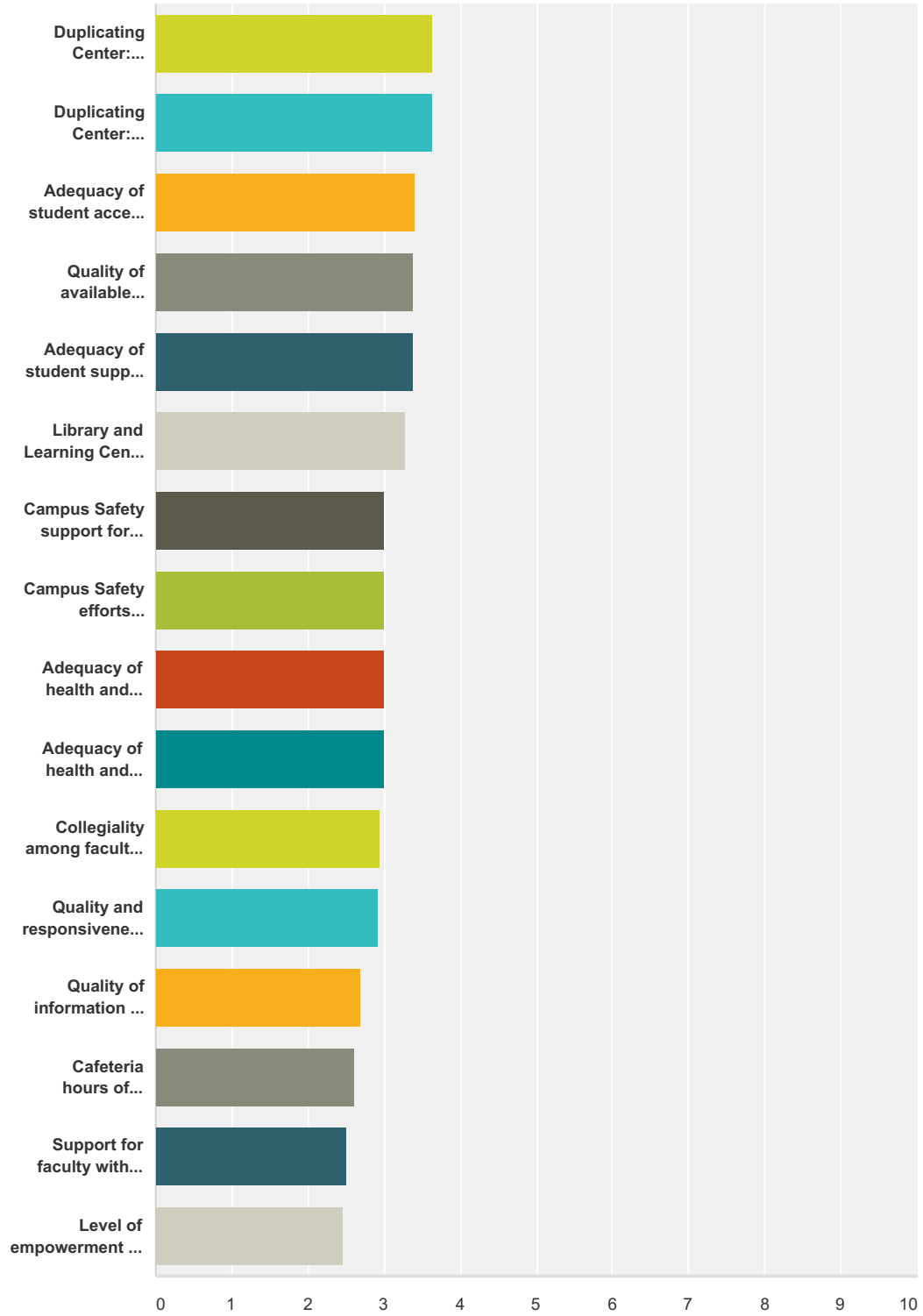
