**RESOLUTION FL02-I: EVALUATION OF THE COMPRESSED CALENDAR**

Whereas, Student Success and student course completion rates are of concern to MJC faculty, and

Whereas, evaluation of change is of critical importance in assessing the success or failure of that change (i.e. the Compressed Calendar), and

Whereas, student utilization of campus labs and student services appears to take place less on Fridays;

Therefore, Be it Resolved that the Academic Senate form an ad hoc committee to draft a document specifying what faculty may want included in research on the effect of the compressed calendar, and

Therefore, Be it Further Resolved that the MJC Academic Senate will present the Senate research committee document and its conclusions to the YFA for consideration in academic calendar negotiations.
