Resolution FL97-D: Criteria and Membership on the Technology Committee

WHEREAS: AB 1725 assures faculty of participation in the prioritization and allocation of college budgets and

WHEREAS: The Technology Committee will oversee the planning and prioritizing of college-wide technology as stipulated by the MJC Master Plan for Technology;

THEREFORE: BE IT RESOLVED that the following criteria and committee membership be approved by the MJC Academic Senate.

MEMBERSHIP CRITERIA

1. Members should be computer literate
2. Members should have experience in educational applications of technology
3. Representatives from a range of academic disciplines are preferred
4. One member slot shall remain open to an instructor with an interest in technology who may not have technical expertise.

MEMBERSHIP COMPOSITION

- Six (6) members selected by the Faculty Senate
- The Dean of Instructional Services with greatest responsibility for instructional technology
- The lead Media manager
- Two Division deans
