CHANGE OF WORDING IN CATALOG
REFERENCE TO PETITION FOR CREDIT BY EXAMINATION**

Proposed by: Curriculum Committee

Whereas: The granting of credit in a course by examination may be less appropriate for some courses than others, and

Whereas: The faculty in a discipline are best able to make a decision as to whether credit for a particular course should, or should not, be available by examination,

Therefore: Be it resolved that the catalog reference to credit by examination should be revised to read "A student may petition for credit by examination in appropriate courses as determined by each division or area provided that the student has evidence of training and/or experience in that subject area".
