WHEREAS, **Articulation is a time-consuming task that requires extensive consulting with officials from other schools, careful analysis and judgment regarding a variety of state regulations, graduation and transfer requirements and the detailed content of programs and courses, and**

WHEREAS, **The Curriculum Committee depends on the advice of the Articulation Officer in developing course outlines that will meet standards for graduation, for general education transfer credit and lower division major preparation, and**

WHEREAS, **The Articulation Officer plays a pivotal role in student success;**

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the MJC Academic Senate strongly recommends immediate full time replacement upon the retirement of the current Articulation Officer.**
