RESOLUTION SP03-G: MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR ASSOCIATE DEGREES**

**April 10, 2003**

**PROPOSED BY:** Curriculum Committee

**WHEREAS,** continuing discussions on the appropriate level of associate degree graduation requirements in English and mathematics have gained currency due to changing high school graduation requirements in those areas, and

**WHEREAS,** it is expected that a number of resolutions on this topic will be presented at the spring plenary session on the state Academic Senate;

**THEREFORE** **Be It Resolved** that the delegate representing Modesto Junior College at the plenary session support the resolution of the state executive committee calling for no changes at this time also directing the preparation of a paper examining this issue. And

**THEREFORE** **Be It Further Resolved** that the Modesto Junior College Academic Senate work with the State Academic Senate to determine the feasibility of an additional associate degree to be designed for students majoring in the occupational and/or technical disciplines and requiring for the degree a high level competence in vocational applications of language and computational skills.
