Intervention After Two Substandard Grades

- Proposed by: Ad-Hoc Third Enrollment Committee
- Whereas: A substandard grade is a D, F or NC but not a W (withdrawal); and
- Whereas: MJC is now requiring students who have received any combination of two withdrawals and/or substandard grades from the same course to petition for a third enrollment attempt; and
- Whereas: Datatel has recently been programmed to enforce blocking students with two substandard grades from the same course and those place on academic probation and/or progress probation; and
- Whereas: A student's counselor is an important resource in career planning and student success; and
- Therefore: Be it resolved, that the Academic Senate recommends that students meet with a counselor to discuss and assess reasons for two substandard grades in two completions of a course to establish an intervention plan prior to being allowed a third enrollment.
- Therefore: Be it further resolved, that the Academic Senate recommends that counselors adopt the "Third Enrollment Request Form" outlining strategies for success.
