Resolution: SP10-E  
Program Viability Procedure**

- Proposed by:** Program Viability Task Force
- Whereas:** The Senate has determined that there are areas of significant improvement possible in our current Program Discontinuance policy; and
- Whereas:** A college's procedure for eliminating or reducing programs is vital to the health of the college, and should be as fair and deliberative as possible; and
- Whereas:** Senate Resolution SP10-A created a task force charged with revising the MJC Program Discontinuance Policy; and
- Whereas:** The Program Viability Task Force has developed an improved procedure document titled *MJC Program Viability Assessment: Revitalization, Reduction, and Discontinuance Procedures*; and
- Whereas:** Title 5 and local Board Policy require 'mutual agreement' in the area of Educational Program Development between the Board and the Senate.
- Therefore:** **Be it resolved,** that the Academic Senate of Modesto Junior College work with the Board of Trustees to establish the document *MJC Program Viability Assessment: Revitalization, Reduction, and Discontinuance Procedures* as the college's official procedure for assessing program viability.
