**RESOLUTION: SP96-A  
(As Amended January 25, 1996)  
CHANCELLOR "NO CONFIDENCE" VOTE**

- Proposed by:** Academic Senate Executive Committee
- WHEREAS,** the Chancellor, Pamila Fisher, has engaged in a continuous abuse of power, and
- WHEREAS,** during the final stages of the MJC presidential search process, the Chancellor refused to meet with the duly constituted and confidential Search Committee to discuss the "open forum" vote, the candidates' confidential background checks, and allow for a final recommendation from the Search Committee, and
- WHEREAS,** the Chancellor continually acts to separate faculty from providing input to the Board of Trustees and the preponderance of testimony on any issue is given by the Chancellor to the Board of Trustees in closed session, and input from staff is only accepted after complete discussions and decisions have been undertaken in Board of Trustees closed sessions, and
- WHEREAS,** the Chancellor has excluded the District Council and the Academic Senates in the process of building the Board of Trustees agenda, and
- WHEREAS,** the Chancellor has attempted to divide the faculty and the classified staff by means of derogatory remarks in writing, and
- WHEREAS, the Chancellor has insulted all staff by accepting an inequitably high raise, and
- WHEREAS, the Chancellor has shown little willingness to listen to, to cooperate with, or to engage in genuine shared governance with faculty in spite of lip-service given to the A.B. 1725 (Shared Governance Law),
- THEREFORE,** **be it resolved that** the Academic Senate for Modesto Junior College declares a "No Confidence" vote in Chancellor Pamila Fisher, and directs the Executive Committee to inform the Board of Trustees of Yosemite Community Colleges of the "no confidence" vote, and

THEREFORE, be it further resolved that the Academic Senate of Modesto Junior College directs the Executive Committee to formally request that the evaluation process and criteria used in the evaluation of Chancellor Pamila Fisher that was completed in July of 1995 be disclosed in writing to the MJC Academic Senate, and that the Board of Trustees shall include the terms and provisions of the Chancellor's new contract, and

THEREFORE, be it further resolved that the Academic Senate of Modesto Junior College directs the Executive Committee to recommend that the Board of Trustees conduct a formal evaluation of the Chancellor in 1996, which would include a written evaluation from the District Council, the YFA, and the two college Academic Senates, and

THEREFORE, be it further resolved that the Board of Trustees respond to this resolution, point by point, in writing, by March 1, 1996.
