**DISABILITIES THEME FOR SPRING 1997  
INSTITUTE DAY**

WHEREAS, Under the aegis of district agreements pursuant to AB1725, the faculty participation in Institute Day, as a faculty development activity, is primarily under the supervision of the Academic Senate and the responsibility of the Academic Senate, and

WHEREAS, for the Spring Institute Day 1997, faculty activities are schedule to be separate from staff activities, and

WHEREAS, faculty participants in the Institute Day committee have already submitted for the Academic Senate's approval a theme for the faculty development activities in Spring 1997 Institute Day, "People with Disabilities, the ADA (Americans with Disabilities Act) and MJC,": along with a number of ideas for its possible development, and

WHEREAS, the theme "People with Disabilities, the ADA and MJC" is considered by the Academic Senate to be an excellent choice, containing a rich variety of potential topics and activities relevant and interesting to MJC faculty and the MJC and Modesto community beyond, and

WHEREAS, the faculty Senate has approved of that theme, and furthermore unanimously commended the faculty on the Institute Day Committee for its work, and

WHEREAS, The same theme was selected by the Institute Day Committee last Spring, with the concurrent of the Academic Senate, for the Fall 1995 Institute Day, but its implementation was delayed.

THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Academic Senate for Modesto Junior College reaffirms its approval and commendation of the choice of the Spring 1997 theme and offers in the strongest terms its support of the Institute Day Committee's co-chairs and faculty membership.
