CUSTODIAL AND GROUNDS STAFF

PROPOSED BY: MJC Academic Senate Executive Committee

WHEREAS, the condition of the buildings and grounds at Modesto Junior College is in considerable need of improvement and has a direct relationship upon quality instruction, and

WHEREAS, the administration of District Routine Maintenance Requests lacks specific accountability (a Routine Maintenance Request for 1981 in the Agriculture area is still outstanding), and

WHEREAS, the proposed new software for YCCD maintenance requests has involved no faculty input, and

WHEREAS, custodians are told to not address maintenance issues either by action or by request form, and

WHEREAS, the recent resignation of the District Maintenance and Operations Director provides an opportunity for restructuring, and

WHEREAS, professional pride and support of work ethics is encouraged through smaller organizational structures;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the custodial and grounds staff for both East and West campuses of Modesto Junior College be designated a college service, and located at Modesto Junior College and will be responsible to the administration of Modesto Junior College.
