

**ACADEMIC SENATE
RESOLUTION: SP97-D**

**MASTER PLAN FOR TECHNOLOGY
APPROVAL AND ACCEPTANCE**

Proposed by: Executive Committee
Amended 4/24/97

WHEREAS, there has been a history of random establishment of computer and other high technology labs, and

WHEREAS, that randomness has resulted in a lack of co-ordination of the governance and maintenance of these labs, and

WHEREAS, the valiant efforts to establish staff development for the training and pedagogical use of both the labs and advanced technology is underfunded, and

WHEREAS, the YCCD District Council has decreed that new funds will not be released to either college until Technology Plans for both colleges have been received and accepted by the District Council, and

WHEREAS, the Technology Committee (formerly the Computer Review Committee) has received the April 9, 1997 Final Proposal of the MJC Master Plan for Technology,

THEREFORE, the Academic Senate for Modesto Junior College approves and accepts the April 9, 1997 Final Proposal of the Master Plan for Technology.
