**RESOLUTION: SP97-J  
FACULTY INVOLVEMENT IN INSTITUTIONAL  
PLANNING AND BUDGET DEVELOPMENT**

**PROPOSED BY:** Executive Committee

**WHEREAS,** AB1725 has provided local academic senates with legal responsibilities that include a responsibility for participation in institutional planning and budget development, and

**WHEREAS,** districts and colleges have large budgets, decisions about which are often decided without an established and stipulated process that includes faculty participation in the establishment of priorities, criteria, and budgetary determinations;

**THEREFORE,** BE IT RESOLVED that the Modesto Junior College Academic Senate and the representatives from IAC, the President's Cabinet and the YFA establish a procedural model that includes recommendations for a systematic process for faculty involvement with institutional planning and budget development including allocations of funds for technology, staff development, and all other aspects of issues involving academic and professional matters.
