**RESOLUTION: SP98-C
INCREASED FUNDING FOR NON-CREDIT COURSES**

Proposed by: Jim Higgs, MJC Academic Senate Executive Committee

WHEREAS, over 50% of the students who enroll in the UC and CSU systems are deficient in Math and English, and

WHEREAS, many of our students in our transfer classes have deficiencies in skills that may include: reading, mathematical computation, writing and communication, and

WHEREAS, The Student Success Plan includes reading levels that will be "recommended for success;"

THEREFORE, be it resolved that Modesto Junior College Academic Senate supports legislation to increase funding for non-credit courses. That funding level is currently around \$1,700 per student, which is in contrast to the \$3,300 per student that we receive for credit courses.
