

Modesto Junior College (MJC)
Academic Senate Resolution F19-D:
Recognition for Student Certificate Achievement

Proposed by Senators Tristin Hassell and Layla Spain

Whereas: Students who earn an Associate of Arts or Associate of Sciences in any major have the right to participate in the Modesto Junior College Annual Commencement Ceremony and have their names placed in the commencement program; and,

Whereas: Students who earn a Certificate of Achievement in an academic, career, technical or professional field are not currently recognized at the Commencement Ceremony; and,

Whereas: There is no formalized, institution-wide mechanism to recognize the educational milestone of certificate achievement and many students who earn a Certificate of Achievement want to be recognized at the annual Modesto Junior College Commencement Ceremony by having their names placed in the commencement program.

Therefore, be it resolved: All students who earn a Certificate of Achievement or Skills Recognition Award of at least 12 credit units shall, at minimum, be asked to stand and be recognized and also have their names in the program of the Modesto Junior College Commencement Ceremony.
