RESOLUTION FL93-S: LAST DAY TO WITHDRAW
FROM A FULL-TERM CLASS WITHOUT PENALTY
AUGUST 26, 1993

PROPOSED BY: EXECUTIVE BOARD

WHEREAS: Each student enrolled in a class has an equal claim on the attention of the instructor and on the time available for classroom participation, and

WHEREAS: Students who eventually withdraw command a share of that attention and time before they actually do withdraw, and

WHEREAS: Those students who remain in the class until its conclusion would be better served by the early withdrawal of those who do not intend to complete the class, and

WHEREAS: A petition procedure for honest mistakes on the part of the student or instructor is still in place,

BE IT RESOLVED: That the last day to withdraw from a full-term class (51 hours) without penalty is the last day of the week that constitutes the first 45% of the semester (23 hours).

DISPOSITION: Failed
