RESOLUTION FL93-Z: ENVIRONMENTAL COMMITTEE
NOVEMBER 18, 1993

PROPOSED BY: EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

WHEREAS: many decisions that impact the physical environment and development of the two Modesto Junior College campuses are currently generated by different departments, units, and committees, and

WHEREAS: Modesto Junior College is a community of inter-related services and departments whose plans and subsequent actions affect one another, and

WHEREAS: Modesto Junior College is an educational community that recognizes the need to serve its students in an efficient, stimulating and aesthetically pleasing environment, and

WHEREAS: there is presently no college-wide committee or body whose charge is sufficiently broad to review and assure coordination of all campus developmental and environmental policies,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Modesto Junior College Environmental Committee be empowered to serve as the central body for the review of all such projects and the recommendations of appropriate projects to the College Council or other implementing bodies. Further, the Environmental Committee shall continue to represent administrative, classified, faculty and student representation to be appointed by their respective organizations.
