RESOLUTION FL97-O: LOCAL SENATE SIGN OFF**

**Proposed by:** Academic Senate for California Community Colleges

**WHEREAS,** legislation, guidelines and revisions for programs in response to welfare reform are continually occurring, and

**WHEREAS,** considerable funding for colleges is at stake;

**THEREFORE,** be it resolved that the Modesto Junior College Academic Senate urge the State Chancellor's Office to continue to inform local senate presidents of all issues relating to the community college's role in welfare reform, and

**THEREFORE,** be it further resolved that the Modesto Junior College Academic Senate ensure that all regular curriculum procedures be followed in dealing with welfare reform issues at their colleges, and

**THEREFORE,** be it finally resolved that the Modesto Junior College Academic Senate urge the senate president to refuse to sign off on curriculum changes made in response to welfare reform unless the regular procedures and proper curriculum process have been followed.
