3570 Smoking on Campus

In accordance with Sections 6404.5 of the California Labor Code, smoking is prohibited in all facilities and District vehicles and within 20 feet of all public building entrances. The colleges and/or District office may further limit smoking to designated smoking areas. For safety concerns, the colleges and/or District office may temporarily ban all smoking from an entire site. Selling or distributing smoking materials and tobacco products on District property is prohibited.

Administrative Procedure

3570 Smoking on Campus

Note: Local practice may be inserted so long as it is consistent with that provided in the example, which is the minimum required by law.

Smoking is prohibited within 20 feet of a main exit, entrance, or operable window of any campus building.

Smoking is prohibited inside any indoor area of any campus building, except for covered parking lots and residential space.

“Covered parking lot” means an area designated for the parking of vehicles that is enclosed or contains a roof or ceiling, but does not include lobbies, lounges, waiting areas, stairwells, and restrooms that are a structural part of the parking lot or a building to which it is attached.

“Residential space” means a private living area, but does not include common areas such as lobbies, lounges, waiting areas, elevators, stairwells, and restrooms that are a structural part of a multi-complex building such as a dormitory.

Smoking is prohibited in any enclosed place of employment on campus, including lobbies, lounges, waiting areas, stairwells, and restrooms that are a structural part of any building that is a place of employment.

Priority shall be given to a smoke-free learning and working environment.

~~Under no circumstances will smoking be permitted in any indoor facilities.~~

Smoking is permitted outside of buildings, but no closer than 20 feet from any doorway, and 50 feet from any areas containing gas or other combustible equipment/liquids.

Following a careful review of environmental conditions, each College President and the Director of Facilities, Planning and Operations may designate and post selected outdoor locations as non-smoking areas.

Outdoor non-smoking areas shall be subject to periodic review and possible change.

Employees and students will be encouraged to voluntarily comply with this policy and procedure. Persistent violations will be grounds for disciplinary action.

Cigarette and tobacco products will not be sold on campus.
