Dear Curriculum Committee Members:

The AGEC 210 course outline was recently revised and approved by the committee at the 3/17/09 meeting. Since that time, the Chancellor's Office has provided new guidelines for TBA hours. In order to meet course compliance, I am requesting expedited approval of the removal of the TBA hours and approval of adjustment of the course format from a 2-unit lecture/1-unit lab course to a 3-unit lecture course, effective Summer 2010. I understand this change will require revisions to the content and learning goals sections in the course outline in CurricUNET; I will work with curriculum leadership to revise the outline accordingly if the request is approved.

Rationale: Other community colleges and universities utilize a strictly lecture format. To remain in compliance with transfer institutions, this course needs to be modified. Additionally, in order to better comply with the recommendations from the most recent accreditation committee's concern with the recording and documentation of hours arranged, the students will be better served using a lecture format.
