Good Morning All,

I am just catching up on the chain of emails going around this week about the appropriateness of substituting Calculus for Business Calculus in the Business ADT.

The Business FDRG met last year to discuss this issue and agreed that the substitution of Calculus for Business Calculus was appropriate and that this would be included on the TMC and CO Template when they are up for five-year review this fall. This recommendation was reviewed by the CSU chancellor's office, vetted by campus Business faculty, and was determined to be appropriate.
