The two exceptions were our NR 200 Soils and Math 161 course. NR Soils: The text was 8 years old and UC requires 7 years as the limit. No worries!!! Ag folks, simply resubmit a new text option for our (your) first September curriculum meeting. MATH 161: Trigonometry if taught as a separate course is not UC-transferable. In the past we allowed text updates to appear as 'notification items' on the curriculum agenda. Barbara, or the new AO, or Heather can make the text book changes in Curricunet. In October, the new AO can resubmit the new COR to OSCAR/ASSIST for the second round of UC-TCA reviews. Please share the decisions with appropriate folks in your division. Heather or new AO, please reflect the UC transferability in Curricunet (CSU & UC), and in the catalog addendum. New AO needs to update the UC-TCA resource document used by the counselors, etc...
