- **Academic Program Highlights: Nursing, Lisa Riggs**
 - No longer using lottery. Now they have 5 criteria and points are used
 - Online Application
 - Summer Work Experience available for students
 - Only 25% who apply get into program
 - Our students have a 94% pass rate for state board
 - 98% of our graduates are finding employment within a year at hospitals
