Reporting Structure:

The ADA Committee serves in an advisory capacity to Facilities Council to create a climate that respects disability as an aspect of diversity and to ensure that individuals with disabilities are able to acquire and access information, interactions, and services towards their success.

Charge:

The ADA Committee reviews potential barriers to equal access to the programs, services, and activities of MJC and recommends solutions.

The Committee prepares an annual prioritization of projects and reviews progress made in the past year on resolving access barriers.

Meetings:

The ADA Committee will meet twice each semester and will seek input from the campus community to identify potential barriers to equal access for individuals with disabilities.

The ADA Committee will review potential barriers to equal access and will recommend solutions. The committee will prepare an annual prioritization of projects to address access and forward to Facilities Council.

The committee is comprised of representatives from various divisions, departments, programs and services that make up the college.
