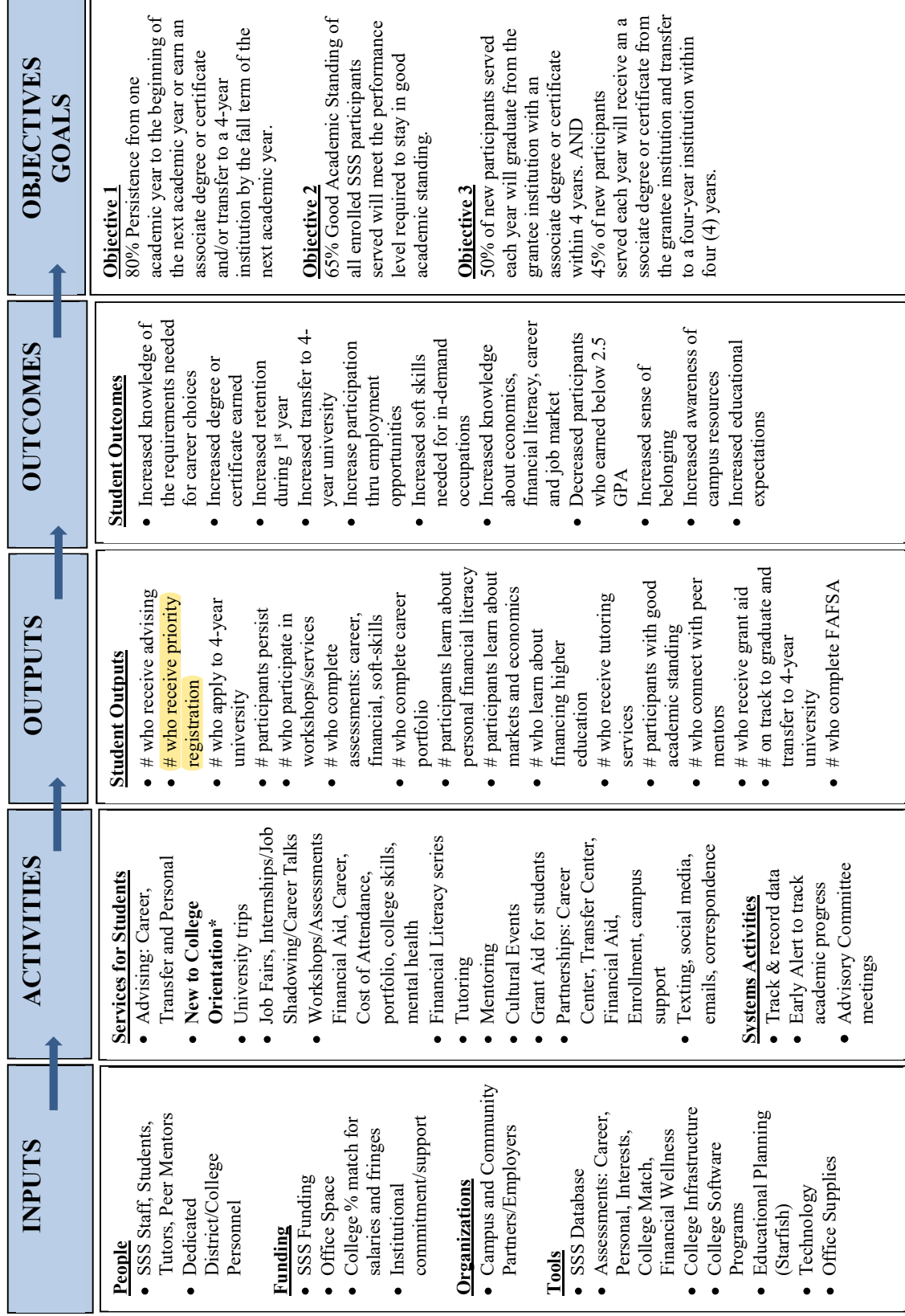


**LOGIC MODEL**

## INSTITUTIONAL COMMITMENT

MJC is committed to the support and success of the TRIO SSS Program. The following table outlines facilities, equipment, supplies, and personnel committed by the college to the Program.

### Committed Facilities, Equipment, Supplies, Personnel, and Other Resources to Supplement the Grant and Enhance Project Services

College Area	Institutional Commitment
<b>Student Services</b>	10% of Counselor/Director's salary and fringes 5% of Program Advisor's salary and fringes <i>To be contributed by the College</i>
<b>Library &amp; Learning Center</b>	Tutoring services; student collaboration meeting rooms; Workshops on online academic research and citations; Database and assistance finding and requesting academic articles.
<b>Career Center</b>	Related workshops, one-on-one assistance with resumes and interview prep; personal interest and career assessments; employment database, internships, job fairs, etc.
<b>Transfer Center</b>	Transfer requirements for 4-year universities; Assistance with transfer applications as well as consistent transfer information.
<b>College Admin Services</b>	Accounting services; facility maintenance; equipment maintenance and replacement.
<b>Counseling Center</b>	College-wide courses and workshops; student referrals to SSS program.
<b>Health Services</b>	Free health assessments; referral to outside health and mental health agencies when needed, Pirates Pantry to help with food insecurities.
<b>Disability Services (DSPS)</b>	Consultation with SSS students to identify accommodations; program promotion; SSS staff training.
<b>Enrollment Services</b>	Priority registration for SSS students; maintains student academic records.
<b>Foundation</b>	SSS student scholarships; staff development funding.
<b>Facilities</b>	Dedicated office, tutoring and counseling area for SSS students, use of classrooms, computer labs, libraries, space for student celebrations.
<b>Student Financial Services</b>	Staff training in current financial aid requirements; eligibility verification; student referrals to program; student record maintenance, financial aid presentations, financial literacy student counseling and advising/training.
<b>YCCD Human Resources</b>	Promotes and facilitates recruitment and hiring of all program personnel; oversees all personnel needs and transactions.
<b>Instructional Divisions</b>	Consultation with SSS staff for student academic needs; monitor academic progress and collaborate with student and staff for intervention.
<b>Associated Students of MJC</b>	Promote and refer students to SSS, provides opportunities for SSS students to join the LEAD Project, provides Free Lunch On Wednesdays (FLOW), campus involvement/Clubs.
