- Responsibility of YCCD ITS

Members of the committee participated in a 2 hour planning session to review goals and objectives of the CTC Plan. Some objectives were combined or taken out because of the duplication, completion or because of changes due to ITS moving to Central Services several years ago. New ideas were not discussed in depth but were collected to explore further at the next planning session. "Parking lot" ideas included:

- CTC could serve as a review committee for technology questions, projects and priorities
- CTC needs to develop a strong partnership with YCCD ITS
- Training ideas included a Technology Institute where stakeholders could explore new ideas
- A new technology survey could provide valuable feedback from college stakeholders

CTC plans to hold one or two more Compression Planning sessions to complete the revision of the MJC Technology Plan.
