MJC JUDGING CONTEST COMMITTEE - INDIVIDUAL CONTEST RULES AND PROCEDURES

- PLEASE READ CAREFULLY, MANY CONTESTS HAVE CHANGED

- NO ELECTRONIC DEVICES AT CONTEST SITES

- FOR THOSE CONTESTS WHERE A FOUR-MEMBER TEAM IS DESIGNATED, THE TOP THREE SCORES WILL COMPRISE THE FINAL TEAM SCORE FOR SUB-CONTEST AND OVERALL TEAM AWARDS. WHERE ALTERNATES ARE ALLOWED, THOSE ALTERNATES WILL BE ELIGIBLE FOR INDIVIDUAL AWARDS.

2022 FIELD DAY CONTESTS:

○ **AGRICULTURAL EXPERIENCE TRACKER - (FORMERLY FARM RECORD BOOK):**

EAST CAMPUS – FOUNDERS HALL, LOBBY

The Curricular Code will be followed. Each school may enter one official four-member team with the top three scores comprising the team score. Limit two alternates per school. All contestants will be eligible for individual awards.

REGISTRATION FEE: \$12 PER STUDENT.

○ **AGRICULTURAL MECHANICS:**

EAST CAMPUS – AG SHOP PARKING COMPOUND ON WEST SIDE OF AG BUILDING

Limit to 35 teams. The Curricular Code will be followed. Each school may enter ‘one’ official four-member team with the top three scores comprising the team score. no alternates allowed.

The evaluation areas are as follows: Tools and Materials Identification / Written Test, Arc Welding Skills, Problem Solving / Plan Interpretation, Electrical Skills, Cold metal and sheet metal fabrication skills/tool sharpening and maintenance, Oxyfuel welding and cutting skills.

LIST OF REQUIRED TOOLS WILL BE POSTED ON OUR WEBSITE TWO WEEKS PRIOR TO THE CONTEST.

REGISTRATION FEE: \$20 PER STUDENT.

○ **AGRICULTURAL PEST:**

WEST CAMPUS – SIERRA HALL BUILDING

The Curricular Code will be followed. Each school may enter one official four-member team with the top three scores comprising the team score. There will be no limit to the number of alternates per school. All contestants will be eligible for individual awards.

REGISTRATION FEE: \$12 PER STUDENT.

○ **AGRONOMY:**

EAST CAMPUS – CENTER FOR ADVANCED TECHNOLOGY BUILDING (CAT), 2nd FLOOR

The revised 2016 Agronomy Curricular Code will not be followed, but we will follow the previous code as close as possible. The use of cell phones during the contest is grounds for team disqualification. Each school may enter one official four-member team with the top three scores comprising the team score. There will be no limit to the number of alternates per school. All contestants will be eligible for individual awards.

REGISTRATION FEE: \$12 PER STUDENT.

○ **BEST INFORMED GREENHAND:**

EAST CAMPUS – (FORUM 101)

Open to freshman only. No alternates allowed. Each chapter may enter one 5-member team. The Curricular Code will not be followed. The top three scores will count towards team total with all five being eligible for individual awards. Contestants will be given TWO hours to take the BIG test which has 200 questions.

REGISTRATION BEGINS @ 9:00 A.M. CONTEST BEGINS @ 9:30 A.M.

EACH CONTESTANT SHOULD BRING 2 (SHARPENED) - #2 PENCILS.

○ **DAIRY CATTLE JUDGING:**

WEST CAMPUS – DAIRY UNIT

Please arrive and get students identified to the clerks so they may receive their judging packets. All schools will be pre-assigned and reason orders done in advance. We will be following curricular code. There will be 3 cow classes, 3 heifer classes, 3 sets of reasons and a written exam. Students should bring a large clipboard for their judging card scantron sheet along with their judging booklet to take notes. A team consists of 4 members with all 4 scores contributing to the team score. There will be no limit to the number of paid alternates per school. Each alternate will pay the individual registration fee. All contestants will be eligible for individual awards.

○ **FARM BUSINESS MANAGEMENT:**

EAST CAMPUS - FOUNDERS HALL LOBBY

The Curricular Code will be followed. Each school may enter one official four-member team with the top three scores comprising the team score. Limit two alternates per school. All contestants will be eligible for individual awards.

REGISTRATION FEE: \$12 PER STUDENT.

○ **FARM POWER & MACHINERY:**

WEST CAMPUS – PARKING LOT 208 – NEAR MARY STUART ROGERS BUILDING

The Curricular Code will be followed. Each school may enter one (1) official three-member team and one alternate. The first 30 teams will be allowed to compete. **No exceptions!**

REGISTRATION FEE: \$15 PER STUDENT.

○ **FLORICULTURE:**

EAST CAMPUS – PARKING LOT 102 – EAST OF AG BUILDING

Limit to 50 teams. The Curricular Code will be used as a guide, but may not be followed in its entirety. Each school may enter only 'ONE' Official Four-Member team with the top 4 scores comprising the team score. No additional Alternates may compete.

There will be a Preliminary contest. Potentially parts of the contest will be completed online on Friday evening before the contest. After the Preliminary Rounds tabulations will be run on and the Top 15 teams will be announced to compete in the final construction rounds. All ID and judging classes will be available for all eliminated teams to go through for review with their coaches. The winning teams and top 10 finalists will be determined from the top 15 qualifying teams based upon their preliminary round score, Reasons scores, and construction round scores.

REGISTRATION FEE: \$15.00 PER STUDENT.

○ **LIVESTOCK JUDGING:**

WEST CAMPUS - ACE PAVILION

There will be 11 classes of livestock and four sets of reasons, one for each species (beef cattle, sheep, goats, and swine). There will be a written test consisting of 25 multiple choice questions. Beef reasons will be the performance reasons. Each school will designate one **four-member** official team. There will no limit to the number of alternates per school. All contestants will be eligible for individual awards.

Purpose and Standards

The Marketing Plan Career Development Event seeks to effectively prepare students for the opportunities and expectations of the agricultural business workplace. Students seeking careers in the agricultural business industry must develop a high degree of knowledge and skill as well as the capacity to create and present a marketing plan. This competition should help to develop partnerships and improve relations with local agricultural industries, FFA chapters and the general public.

Contestants

Teams shall consist of three members. Alternates are not allowed in this competition.

Classes

Marketing Plan is a team competition with no individual scoring

○ **MARKETING COOPERATIVES:**
WEST CAMPUS – SIERRA HALL

Each chapter may enter a team of three to five members. The top three scores will count towards team total with all five being eligible for individual awards. Contestants will be given TWO hours to take the test which has 100 questions. There will be no limit to the number of paid alternates per school. Each alternate will pay the individual registration fee. All contestants will be eligible for individual awards.

EACH CONTESTANT SHOULD BRING 2 (SHARPENED) - #2 PENCILS.

○ **MEATS JUDGING:**

WEST CAMPUS – SIERRA HALL

The contest will consist of Retail Classes, Wholesale Classes, Product I.D., and Written Test. Details of the contest will be emailed to the coaches after the registration deadline. Schools are allowed to enter five (5) contestants consisting of a three-member team and two alternates. All contestants will be eligible for individual awards.

REGISTRATION @ 7:30 A.M. ON WEST CAMPUS IN THE SIERRA BUILDING.

CONTEST WILL BE LIMITED TO 60 CONTESTANTS

REGISTRATION FEE: \$25 PER STUDENT.

○ **MILK QUALITY AND DAIRY FOODS:**

WEST CAMPUS – MARY STUART ROGERS BUILDING - LOBBY ENTRANCE

The Curricular Code will be followed. Each school may enter one official four-member team with all four individual scores counting as the team score. Teams with less than four individuals are considered individual alternates.

UNLIMITED NUMBER OF ALTERNATES.

REGISTRATION FEE: \$20.00 PER STUDENT.

○ **NURSERY/LANDSCAPE:**

EAST CAMPUS – PARKING LOT 102 – EAST OF AG BUILDING

The Curricular Code will be followed as to classes offered. Each school may enter one official four-member team with the top three scores comprising the team score. There will be no limit to the number of alternates per school. All contestants will be eligible for individual awards. Scantron answer sheets will be used in I.D. and the knowledge test.

EACH CONTESTANT SHOULD BRING TWO - #2 PENCILS.

REGISTRATION FEE: \$12 PER STUDENT.

○ **POULTRY JUDGING:**

WEST CAMPUS –POULTRY UNIT

The Curricular Code will be followed. Each school may enter one official four-member team with the top three scores comprising the team score. There will be no limit to the number of alternates per school. All contestants will be eligible for individual awards.

BIOSECURITY MEASURES WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED! PLEASE INSTRUCT YOUR STUDENTS NOT TO HAVE POULTRY CONTACT 72 HOURS PRIOR TO THE CONTEST.

○ **SMALL ENGINES:**

WEST CAMPUS –TENAYA COMPLEX / AUTO BODY SHOP

PLEASE NOTE: WILL BE USING MODEL 12S432 OR EQUIVALENT ENGINES.

The Curricular Code will be followed. EACH SCHOOL MAY ENTER ‘ONE’ OFFICIAL THREE-MEMBER TEAM WITH ALL THREE SCORES COMPRISING THE TEAM SCORE. There will be no limit to the number of alternates per school; however, **alternates will not be able to trouble-shoot.**

EACH TEAM WILL BE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE A TROUBLESHOOTING JUDGE.

○ **VETERINARY SCIENCE:**

EAST CAMPUS – CENTER FOR ADVANCED TECHNOLOGY BUILDING (CAT) 1ST FLOOR

Limit to 40 teams. The Curricular Code will be followed. Each school may enter ‘one’ official four-member team with the top three scores comprising the team score. There will be no alternates allowed. No exceptions!
