- California Dream Act Application (online) No deadline; Still processing 2018 applications. Will start 2018/19; 2 weeks allowance in the fall; every other time Financial Aid is a week out
- BOG Waiver is now California College Promise Grant – CCPG; Waives Tuition
- Cal Grant C
- Full Time Student Success Grant – enrolled in 12 units & receiving Cal Grant
- CCCG California College Completion Grant - \$1,500 Academic Year **new this year!*
- **Focus Groups**
 - Foster Youth – Chafee Foundation
 - Dreamers – 1 time Emergency fund
 - Homeless (Food Pantry)
 - Dependency Overrides (see Peggy; special situation)
- **Federal Pell**
 - 17/18 \$5,920
 - 18/19 \$5,950
- **Additional Aid**
 - Federal Work Study – must turn in pay claim = hours worked
 - SEOG – Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant \$1,000
- **Return to Title IV (R2T4)**
 - Students should check with Financial Aid before dropping classes
 - May owe funding back and/or
 - May no longer meeting Satisfactory Academic Progress
- **The college could collect be liable in paying the students debt**
 - Keep an attendance roster
 - Drop students from roster right away
 - Do no wait until census to drop students from the course
 - Last day of ATTENDANCE is important to our reporting
