- I understand that appropriate professional dress is required of volunteers in the Early Care & Education program. Clothing worn should cover the front and back of the body appropriately and should not have any inappropriate words or pictures that might be offensive to others. Shoes must be appropriate without a heel or a very low heel.
- I understand there may be days when the ratio of adults to children may be already adequate for an optimal environment for the children and help may not be beneficial in the actual classroom with the children. It is possible to have too many adults in a child-centered classroom. If this occurs, which is rare, there are many possibilities for participating including cutting out art projects, filing, gardening, bulletin boards, etc.
- I understand that in a lab environment one of the biggest needs for participants in the Early Care & Education Program is washing buckets, buckets of toys and equipment to keep our classroom clean and sanitized along with preparing bulleting boards, preparing materials for all curriculum activities such as art, science, math, and literacy. Families are welcome to take home a bucket of toys to wash at home too.
- I understand that my child is developing the skills of making friends and sustaining friendships; therefore, I may not follow my child, as it may be disruptive to his/her ability to connect emotionally with his/her toddler family. However, I may observe my child.
- Each semester your toddler is enrolled throughout the academic year (summer, fall and spring) one parent/guardian from each family is required to enroll in, attend and successfully complete an 8 hour evening class, FAMLF 355x. Regular MJC tuition and fees apply to this class. Parents are required to participate in the classroom twice during the semester.
- I understand with the support of the lab instructor or lab assistant, each calendar year one family member is expected to plan and facilitate one developmentally appropriate curriculum activity that represents an important part of the family's culture such as singing, playing instruments, reading, art, math, science, cooking, etc. Please sign up for a date during the summer session.
