The Basics

- SLO stands for Student Learning Outcomes.
- SLOs at Modesto Junior College are the overarching, expected learning results for students that we aim to achieve across our institution.
- SLOs are primarily student-focused, and they are measurable across a variety of contexts.
- Course-related SLOs are known as CLOs or CSLOs.
- Instructors measure their CLOs per their set criteria and input that information in eLumen (database for managing SLOs).
- Every course is assessed based on a schedule created by each department. Courses are assessed at least once in a span of two years.
- SLOs play an important role in institutional improvement.

SLOs at the institutional level are called ILOs or ISLOs.

SLOs at the program level are called PLOs or PSLOs.

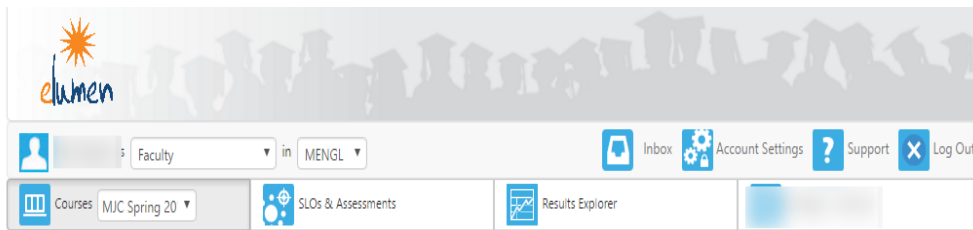
